Meals

Meal Plan A: \$50 - Includes Tuesday picnic and Thursday banquet.

Meal Plan B: \$65 - Includes Tuesday picnic, contest lunch, awards luncheon and Thursday banquet. This meal plan is for contestants, coaches and other conference participants planning to attend the contest awards (third through 10th place) luncheon.

Additional tickets are available for the awards luncheon (\$20) and banquet (\$30) on Thursday for parents/family members who would like to attend. These tickets will need to be purchased in advance. Tickets can be picked up at conference headquarters in the Lory Student Center.
